

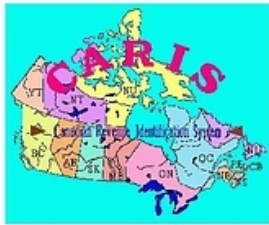
PUBLICATIONS ON COMPUTER DISK

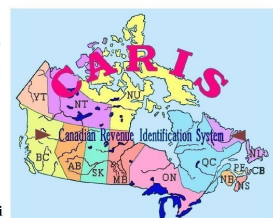

World War Two Rationing Books and Coupons of Canada and Newfoundland

Rationed items include food, gasoline, tires and alcohol. This disk also contains some supplementary information, including a detailed Philatelic Glossary.

Each disk contains many files of three types: (1) HTML files readable by all compatible internet browsers (such as Firefox, Chrome, etc.), (2) PDF files readable by Adobe Acrobat Reader, and (3) JPG images presented at 300 pixels per inch, which makes for beautiful, detailed images on screen. Some images are presented at 600 pixels when greater detail is needed. The HTML files and all their supporting files will run on recent versions of Windows and Apple software using compatible browsers. Each disk will be created especially for each buyer, with his or her full name and unique serial number being recorded on the software's Index Page, as shown at the bottom of the image on the next page.

This DVD contains 6,882 files totalling 4.14 gigabytes of data. Contents comprise 1,171 directories that contain 540 HTML browser files, 212 printable Adobe Acrobat PDF files, and 5,585 supporting JPG images.

For each "subject," a **detailed checklist can be printed and placed in a separate "collector's" booklet.**

At right is the design of the "Index Page" and its hyperlinks, as they will appear on your computer screen. Only a portion of this page will appear at any one time, and "scrolling" will allow viewing its other parts.

Price of Volumes One to Seven and Nine is \$36.95 each, in Cdn dollars, sent postpaid to people living in Canada. **Volume Eight is available for \$232.50 Cdn, and buyers who have previously bought one or more disks may deduct \$36.95 Cdn for each such disk.** Volumes to be placed on a USB drive cost an additional \$5.00 Cdn.


Payments in USD may be made in the amounts of \$25.00 for any single disk and \$157.00 for the comprehensive Volume Eight on DVD. For a USB, add an additional \$5.00. Added postage per disk is \$4.00 to the USA and \$6.00 to an international address. Acceptable methods of payment are money orders, personal cheques from BNAPS members or people known to me, preferred interac e-transfers, or PayPal). But payments via PayPal must add 4.0 percent to cover PayPal commissions. My PayPal name will be provided on receipt of order.
